

Processing and protection of personal data in Common vision o.z. association.

In order to cooperate with your company and the persons acting on its behalf, cooperation with you as a natural person, non-business association, Common Vision o.z. processes personal data provided by individuals. The Common Vision o.z. process personal data under the provisions of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Regulation (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulation")) and pursuant to the provisions of Act No. 18/2018 Z.z. on the Protection of Personal Data and on the Amendment to Certain Acts (the "Act").

In order to comply with legal obligations, the Common Vision o.z. provides the following information:

The purposes of the processing personal data as well as the legal basis of the processing:

Purpose of processing:

- The Common Vision was established as a professional grouping of legal entities and natural persons whose aim is to increase safety on construction sites. At the meetings, training sessions and workshops that we are organize or participate in, we offer the opportunity to exchange professional information as well as experience in the area of safety coordination on sites.

Legal basis:

- Section 6 (1). b) GDPR

Processed personal data - based on the above, we process the following personal data:

- when visiting our web site - IP address, web logs, cookies.

- when attending a seminar, training or workshop - Name, surname, phone number or email address.

We process personal data you provide to us for the following reasons (to fulfill these purposes):

- Services offering
 - Marketing - newsletters - We use your personal data (email and name) for direct marketing - sending emails about our news and ongoing events.
 - If you are our client, we do so on the basis of the existence of a contractual relationship between us, or based on the legitimate interest, since we assume that you are interested in our services.
- Photos and videos from seminars - At some of our events, we create photographic documentation or video footage. We use photos in promotional materials, especially on our web site and on social networks. We never mention the names of the participants in these materials. But if you did not wish to be on the photos or videos, please let us know by mail or by phone.

The recipients or categories of personal data recipients –

- in cases where the provision of your data is required by law or if it is necessary to protect our legitimate interests (such as the courts, the Police of the SR, etc.).

Transmission of personal data to a third country or international organization

– is not implemented.

Personal data retention period – depends on the intended purpose of the processing and on the necessity of archiving according to the company's approved registration plan, which is also based on the intended purpose and the legal basis of the processing of personal data.

Existence of rights against the operator – as a person concerned, you have rights that you can apply to us at your discretion. These are the following rights:

- Right of access – you may request the Operator to access your personal data. An operator shall also provide a copy of the processed personal data.
- Right to obtain the correction – you may request the Operator to correct your inaccurate or incomplete personal data we process.
- Right for deletion - you may ask the Operator to delete your personal information if any of the following:
 - a/ Personal data are no longer required for purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed;
 - b/ You have withdrawn the consent to process your personal data and there is no further legal reason for such processing;
 - c/ You have objected to being the subject of a decision based on the automated processing of your personal data, and there are no prevailing legitimate reasons

for such processing or you have objected to the processing of your personal data for the purposes of direct marketing;

d/ Your personal data has been processed unlawfully;

e/ Your personal data must be deleted in order to comply with a legal obligation laid down in Union or Member State law applicable to the Operator;

f/ Your personal information has been gathered in connection with the offer of the information society services.

- Right to restrict data processing - you may ask the Operator to restrict the processing of your personal data if any of the following:

a/ You have denied the accuracy of your personal data for the time necessary for the Operator to verify the accuracy of the personal data.

b/ It is illegal to process your personal data but refuses to delete these data and instead requests that you limit their use.

c/ An operator no longer requires personal data for processing but you require them to identify, exercise or defend legal claims.

d/ You have objected to the processing of your personal data under Regulation section 21 par. 1, until it has verified that legitimate reasons Operator prevail over your legitimate reasons.

- Right to data portability – in the cases envisaged by the Regulation, you have the right to obtain personal data relating to you and which you have provided to the Operator in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, except that this right may not adversely affect the rights and freedoms of others.

- Right of consent withdrawal – if processing of your personal data is based on consent, you have the right to withdraw the consent to the processing of personal data for the purpose for which you have given consent at any time.

- Right to raise objections – You may at any time raise an objection to the processing of your personal data with the Operator for the purposes of direct marketing performed on the basis of the Operator's legitimate interest.

- Right to file a complaint – you have the right to file a complaint with the Supervisory Authority, which is the Office for Personal Data Protection of the Slovak Republic.

Obligation or ability to provide personal data – If you decide to cooperate with us, communicate or visit our web site, you need to provide us with personal data to the extent necessary. Otherwise, we will not be able to communicate with you, provide you with goods and services, You will not be able to browse our web pages. This does not apply to the processing of cookies that you can change in your browser settings.

Existence of automated decision making including profiling -. When processing personal data for the above purposes, we do not perform automated decision making or profiling.

We declare that, as the operator of your personal data, we meet all statutory obligations required by valid legislation, in particular the Privacy Act, the GDPR, and that:

- we will process your personal data only on the basis of the legitimate interest, the contractual relationship or the granted consent,
- We hereby fulfill the information obligation under Article 13 of the GDPR before the processing of personal data begins,

We will allow you and we will support you in the implementation and fulfillment of your rights under the Personal Data Protection Act and the GDPR.

Securing and protecting your personal information

We protect personal information to the fullest extent possible. We have accepted and maintained all possible technical and organizational measures to prevent the misuse, destruction or of your personal data.

Confidentiality

We would like to assure you that we, as an operator and also our employees and associates, who will process your personal data, are required to maintain confidentiality of your personal data and ensure all security measures. This discretion lasts even after termination of your relation with us. Without your consent, your personal information will not be disclosed to a third party.

This Privacy Policy apply from May 25, 2018 and replace the previous Privacy Policy.
